PROGRAM ITINERARY

This projected itinerary is subject to change based on local conditions and availability

DAY 1 > THURSDAY, DECEMBER 24 | Baruch HaBah – Welcome to Israel!

Arriving a day early helps travelers prepare for the journey. Group rates are available at the arrival hotel in Jerusalem.

- Arrive at Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport on your self-booked flight – a community flight option will be designated for those who wish to travel together
NOTE: An airport VIP greeting and transfer to our Jerusalem hotel is included for all travelers arriving between 6:00am-4:20pm today
- A complimentary “pre-tour” is available for travelers already in Israel from the night before and for travelers arriving to Ben Gurion Airport by 9:30am today
Notify us at least a month in advance if you plan to participate
 - Pick up new skills by taking part in the Tzurim Valley archeological dig
 - Discover the foundations of Jerusalem at the City of David
- Evening: Meet up as a full group and get oriented over a welcome dinner at Joy Restaurant in the Mamilla Complex

DAY 2 > FRIDAY, DECEMBER 25 | The Old City of Jerusalem

- Experience a panoramic introduction to Jerusalem from the Haas Promenade
- Enter the Old City via Zion Gate – Explore the rooftops, alleys, and squares of the Jewish Quarter
- Free time for shopping and lunch in the Cardo area of the Jewish Quarter
- Reflections at the Kotel – The Western Wall — and go deep under the Old City for a tour of the Kotel Tunnels
- Return to our hotel – Freshen up and experience the quiet that descends on Jerusalem as Shabbat approaches
- Option to experience Kabbalat Shabbat at a local synagogue or the Western Wall
- Evening: Enjoy a memorable community Shabbat dinner at the historic Sephardic Center in the heart of the Old City's Jewish Quarter
- Walk back to our hotel and experience the peace of Jerusalem on a Friday night

DAY 4 > SUNDAY, DECEMBER 27 | Loss & Renewal in Israel

- Docent-led tour of the Yad Vashem World Holocaust Remembrance Center
Children's alternative: Tour of the Jerusalem Biblical Zoo
- Explore Jerusalem's bustling and iconic open-air Mahane Yehuda Market – sample the market's multi-ethnic delicacies
- Visit the grounds of the Knesset – Israel's Parliament Building – and stop for a photo-op at the famous National Menorah
- Travel deep into the Judean Desert for a camel riding adventure and a memorable desert tent dinner feast at Eretz Breisheit

DAY 5 > MONDAY, DECEMBER 28 | Adventures in the Judean Desert

- Rise early and summit Masada – Hike the Snake Path or take the cable cars
- Explore and recount the story of Masada – Herod's desert mountaintop fortress and the bastion of an ancient Jewish rebellion
- Descend Masada via cable cars and continue to Ein Bokek Beach at the Dead Sea
- Discover the wonder of effortless floating on the Dead Sea, 1412 ft below sea level
- Short nature walk to Ein Gedi desert oasis – view wild ibex in their habitat
- Check-in and dinner at our accommodations in Be'er Sheva

DAY 6 > TUESDAY, DECEMBER 29 | Resilience along Israel's Gaza Frontier

- Travel to Israel's Western Negev Desert along the frontier with Gaza
- Meet with members of Kibbutz Nachal Oz – Learn how this community is grappling with the past and looking to the future
- Bear witness to the devastation of October 7 at the Nova Music Festival Memorial
- Break for lunch at Kibbutz Tekuma and view the "Tekuma car cemetery" for a different perspective on the October 7th attacks
- Taste the fruits of Israel's desert agricultural revolution at the Salad Trail
- Travel to Tel Aviv — check in and dinner on your own

- Morning: Port-to-port bicycle tour between the Jaffa Seaport and the modern Tel Aviv Port
- Walking tour of the ancient Jaffa Seaport and browse the Jaffa Flea Market
- Break for lunch at Tel Aviv's famous Dr. Shakshuka restaurant
- Channel the innovation edge of modern Israel at the Peres Center for Peace and Innovation
- Group night out and dinner on your own at Tel Aviv's Sarona market
